The following is the Club's Code of Conduct in relation to players:

- 1. Abide by the rules of the game and rules set down by your coach, Club, the SMJFL and the AFL.
- 2. Never argue with an official or umpire.
- 3. Control your temper. Verbal or physical abuse of officials, umpires, spectators or other players is not acceptable or permitted.
- 4. Work equally hard for yourself and your team. Your team's performance will benefit and so will you.
- 5. Be a good sport. Acknowledge all good players whether they be in your team or the other team. Be proud to walk off the ground after each game knowing that you have given your best effort.
- 6. Each team must group and give three cheers to the opposition team and Umpire at the end of the game.
- 7. Treat all players, as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.
- 8. Co-operate with your team officials and teammates.
- 9. Respect the ability of your opponent, without them there would be no game.
- 10. Play for the 'fun of it' and not just to please others.
- 11. Avoid use of derogatory language based on gender, race, religion, ability, colour or sexual preference, orientation or identity.
- 12. Any breach of this code of conduct will not be tolerated and will be dealt with by the MBJFC Disciplinary Sub-Committee.
